



Please note: Opening magazine uses a **large** amount of data.

- One magazine can be 20-100MB
- If you have a 2GB per month plan then you could open 20 magazines per month
- You can **only** read the magazines on your computer **whilst connected to the internet**

You will need:

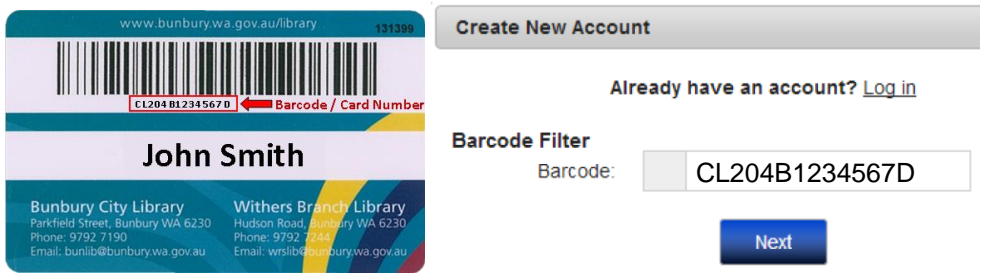
- An email address
- Bunbury Library Card

NB: You cannot save a copy of magazines to your computer, you must be online to enjoy them

1. Go to the website:
<http://slowa.rbdigitalglobal.com/>
2. Click “**Create New Account**” in the top **right** hand corner of the magazine collection page



3. Type in your Barcode (**UPPER CASE, no spaces**) found on the back of your Library Card.



4. Fill in your: **Name, Email** details. **Password** can be whatever you choose, it doesn't have to be same as what you use to log into your email
 - Ensure “**Remember Me**” box is ticked

Remember: This **email** will be how you log into “**RBDigital Magazines**” from now on

An email will confirm you registration is successful (ie. You typed your email address correctly)

- Go to your email inbox:
- Look for an email from **RBDigital** via the State Library of WA with subject line:
“**Welcome to State Library of Western Australia RBDigital Gateway**”

5. To get a magazine

- Tap cover
 - Tap **Checkout**
 - Tap **Keep Browsing** to pick another magazine (You can have 500!)
6. Browse from your library's collection of popular titles with no holds, no checkout periods, and no limit to the number of magazines you can download.
 7. Click on the cover of desired magazine
 - Click **"Start Reading"**
 - Log in yet again
 - Click on the cover of desired magazine
 - Magazine will open in a New Browser Window
 8. Next time you want to read a magazine you've already borrowed:
 - Visit the site: <http://slowa.rbdigitalglobal.com/>
 - Log in (Top Right of screen) using the **Email** and **Password** you used when signing up
 - Click on: [My Collection](#) (Top Right of screen)

Please Note: Although using **RBDigital** online magazines on a computer is less convenient and uses more data because you can't download the magazine to your device it has other features that are great.

When reading a magazine look at the options on the screen because some selected magazine allow you to print out pages and sometimes view articles in text only mode (great for copying recipes!). Look for the picture of the camera to take a screenshot.
