Difference between iPads

iPad with 3G/4G – ability to use a sim card on a mobile data plan for internet usage iPad Wi-Fi only – can connect to Wi-Fi networks at home or in public. No sim card capability

iPad 2017. Cheaper, screen not laminated, no non-reflective, faster iPad Air 2 (lighter & faster, screen feels plastic not glass. 10" screen) AKA iPad 4 iPad Mini 4 (smaller version -7" screen) iPad Pro -13" screen (Really Big)

2 External Buttons and Ports



3 Turn the iPad on/off - Do this weekly

Hold down the power button to turn off/on
Press the power button once to wake/sleep the iPad (if it's already on)

4 Charging the Battery

Connect it to the wall outlet using the USB cable & power adaptor

Connect it to the computer using the USB cable

NB: The newest iPads have different power packs and may not charge via USB or 3rd Party Hardware

5 Home Screen – Parts of the screen

- Status Bar (internet connection, time & battery life)
- Pages (swipe left/right to move to next/previous page)
- **Dock** (most frequently used apps you can SET which these are)
- **Control Centre** (WiFi lives here) quick access swipe up from the bottom of the screen)
- **Notifications** (pull down from the top of screen)

6 Navigation - GETTING AROUND

6.1 Tapping, Holding, Swiping, dragging, pinching & pressing

- **Tap** to "click" or select something on the screen; eg: to open an app or a link. You can also tap and hold to occasionally access other options (think of this as "right-clicking").
- **Drag** to scroll up and down, left and right, or any other direction on the screen.
- Swipe left or right to flip through pages on the Home screen, photos, or pages in an e-book.
- **Pinch** to zoom in or out almost anywhere.

6.2 "Home, sweet home"

Pressing the home button will always take you home to your main home screen (Just like Dorothy's red shoes)

- **Swipe** to another home screen
 - Home
- Tap "Notes", Home
- Tap "Clock", Home
- Tap "Settings", Home



6.3 What's Open?

• Press "Home" button twice (2 times)

These are the apps that are currently **open**. To **switch** back to an app:

- Touch either
 - The image of what is open screen
 - App Icon

Hint:

To get better battery-life and speedier reactions from your iPad:

- Close all apps except the one you are using
 - o **Touch** and **flick** each app, to the top of the screen to **CLOSE**

6.4 Moving and Rearranging App Icons

You can customize the layout of app icons on the Home screen—including the icons in the Dock along the bottom of the screen. If you want, arrange them over multiple Home screens.

Rearrange icons:

- 1 Touch and hold any icon until the icons jiggle.
- 2 Arrange the icons by dragging them.
- 3 Press the **Home button to save your arrangement**.

6.5 Re-Arrange Home screen: Delete an app from the Home screen:

Touch and hold the icon of the app you want to delete until it jiggles and an appears. (After a few seconds an X will appear next to each of the apps you've installed via the App Store.) Tap the to delete the app. When prompted, select Delete.

Important: Deleting an app from iPad also deletes the documents and data created by the app.



6.6 The iPad Included (or Default) Apps

The iPad comes with pre-loaded apps. Each handles a basic task.

Unlike apps you may download, **these apps cannot be deleted** from your iPad.



7 Wi-Fi

- To use most of your iPad's features you must be connected to the Internet.
- Once you join a network, your device will connect to it automatically whenever it's in range.
- If you have a mobile data plan, you do not need to connect to a Wi-Fi network, unless you require more data usage than what you have available.

To connect go to **Settings > Wi-Fi >** turn Wi-Fi **ON** (if not already)





- enter password (network key) if required
 - o No password at library (You should have a password to use Internet at home)



8 Using The Internet



Safari is a web browser that comes built in to the iPad. You'll use it to access websites on your device. Before you can use the internet you will need to be connected to the internet via Wi-Fi or 3G/4G network.

• Click on the Safari icon to begin. At the top of the screen you will see a light grey search bar where you can enter in the website you wish to go to, or enter in a search term which will display a list of results.



- To the left of the search bar:
 - o Back, Forward & Bookmarks (favourites), that you've bookmarked.
- To the right of the search bar
 - o Share-To, New Tab & Currently Open Tabs

Care and Protection

Case, Screen protector, Soft lint-free cloth to clean the screen. Don't use liquids, alcohol, etc.
