

Book Club Set - Information

Welcome to our book club sets! We have a large number of sets of various sizes available for you to use now. We will be expanding or adding to our book club collection when possible throughout the year.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do you know what titles we have available?

Lists of our book club sets are available from our libraries, via our website library.bunbury.wa.gov.au or we can email them through to you.

How can your Book Club access our sets?

To borrow one of our book club sets you must be a registered member of either Bunbury or Withers library. Your club will be issued with a book club library membership card. Book clubs can share this membership amongst their club. Your membership card must be used to borrow book sets from the library.

The set must be borrowed as a total set, if your book club only has 6 members you must still borrow the whole set. An easy way around this is to leave the unused books in the bag until they are due for return.

How do you become a member to borrow book club sets?

To be able to borrow our sets you need to be a member of the City of Bunbury Libraries. We require two members of your book club to be willing to supply their details as book club contacts. One or both will be required to sign and accept the 'conditions of use' on behalf of your book club

How long can you borrow our sets?

The loan period for book clubs will be six weeks. This means the new book set can be collected prior to your next meeting.

How do you know who has what book out of the set?

Each of the books within the set will be individually numbered e.g. 1/8, 2/8. Some book clubs like to allocate a specific number to one of your members. No matter which set you check out this number will be allocated to that member. E.g. 1 – Fred, 2 – Max ...

How do we return the sets?

The books must be returned as a set including the reading notes - if they are present. The complete set can be returned to either Bunbury or Withers. You will not be able to use the returns chute or after hours chute as the bag will not fit. Please ensure you give one of our library staff the bag.

Can a title be reserved for our book club?

Yes - any of our library staff will help you to do this, either in person at one of our branches, contact us on 9792 7190 or email us on bunlib@bunbury.wa.gov.au

What happens if a book for the set is lost or damaged?

As per our library membership for all Patrons, in this case the book club will be financially responsible for the books. If the damage is minor, the library will try to repair the book where possible. If the damage is major, there may be a charge for the book. If the book is lost, then the book club will need to pay for the book or replace the book. It will be left up to you as a book club to decide how you manage this.
